



## **TUITION FEES & LEVIES**

Below is an outline of the College Tuition Fees for 2017 as decided by the College Board of Management. These fees may increase marginally in 2018.

### **TUITION FEES**

YEAR 7 & 8	\$1,775 per student	per year
YEAR 9 & 10	\$1,875 per student	per year
YEAR 11 & 12	\$2,010 per student	per year

### **LEVIES**

#### **Student Levy**

- \$525 per Year 7 student per year.
- \$650 per Year 8-12 student per year.

#### **Resource Levy**

- \$460/\$550 per student (Year 7 & 10).
- \$400/\$440/\$600 per student (Year 8 & 11).

This levy is for the MacBook Program (details of charges can be discussed with the Business Manager)

#### **Maintenance & Building Levy**

- \$420.00 per family per year.

#### **Other Charges**

- Student Diary \$15.00 per student
- College Year Book \$25.00 per family

#### **Elective Charges**

Elective courses fees and VET study fees are not included in the Tuition Fee charge and may incur additional cost to parents.

### **DISCOUNTS**

#### **Third Child**

A discount of \$500.00 will be given off the Tuition Fee for any family who has three children attending the College in the current year.

#### **Fourth Child**

If you have four children attending the College in the current year, there will be no Tuition Fee charged for the youngest child.

### **ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE**

The enrolment process requires a payment of an **Application Fee of \$100** when submitting your child's enrolment form. The enrolment application will not proceed without this fee being paid.

- This fee will be credited to your School Fee account after the enrolment process is completed. In the event that a place is not able to be offered to your child, the fee will be refunded.
- However, in the event that you later change your mind and decide not to accept the 'Offer of Enrolment' for your child, the fee is non-refundable.

### **HOW AND WHEN CAN I PAY MY SCHOOL FEES**

### **GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE**

The State government has introduced the **Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF)**. This is to assist eligible families to cover the cost of school camps and excursions. If you hold a valid means-tested concession card, you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards these expenses. The annual amount for a secondary student is \$225. If eligible, please contact our office to obtain an application form.
